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Evaluation of the Application

Once the applications are received along with the PhD thesis and other relevant documents, they will be evaluated by the Expert Committee. The shortlisted PhD holders will be invited for an oral presentation before the Expert Committee.

The Committee will consider the originality/novelty of the work, methodological rigour, quality of thesis presentation, and quality of published papers from the thesis (based on impact factor and citations) among other things provided in a prescribed evaluation criterion. The decision of the OSI GC based on the recommendation of the Expert Committee will be final.
